end, with candles held high in air with one hand on their heart, these prisoners took an oath to move towards higher wisdom and hope.

For Patel, the motivational programme for prisoners was perhaps the most satisfying. "There are too many peo-

ple to tell them about their mistake and too few to make them feel their worth or inspire them for a better life," he says, "They don't need preachings, they need practical ways to deal with life," he adds.
